

## Windows 10 – Resize Images (Using Paint).


Images for competition have to be a maximum of 1600 pixels X 1200 pixels.

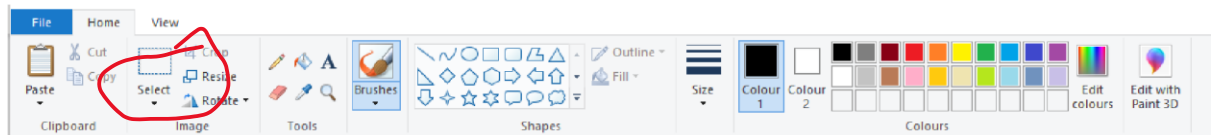
So ideally 1600 X 1200 pixels

1600 X 1000, or 1200 X 1200, or 1500 X 1150 are OK

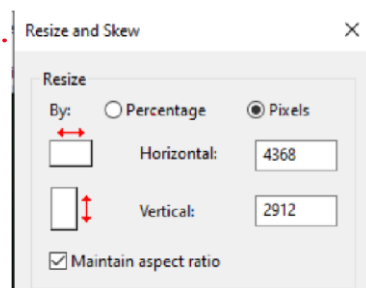
**But 1600 X 1600 isn't!**

Easy enough to achieve on Windows or Mac using Lightroom or Photoshop as well as others, but this sheet describes the Windows Operating System version.

1. Open File Explorer ( on the taskbar) and locate the .jpg image you need to resize;
2. Right click on the file and select “Open With” and then select “Paint”;
3. From the Menu Bar Click on the Resize option;



4. From the Resize and Skew Screen select the Pixels option:



5. If the By: isn't “pixels”, then click in the window to select Pixels;
6. Make sure “Maintain aspect ratio” is ticked. Ignore Skew;
7. Bearing in mind the maximum dimensions, above, change either width to 1600 or height to 1200. The other dimension will change automatically;
8. If either one is over 1600 (wide) or 1200 (height) change that number;
9. Click “OK”;
10. Click on “File” and select “Save”;
11. Close Paint;
12. Back on the File Explorer Window right click the image file;
13. Select “Rename”;

14. Change the filename to “Title – Your Name”. Note spaces around the “-”, so it might be: “Another Sunset – Felix Merryweather”. Make sure the type (after the dot) is “JPG” or “jpg”. If not change it and press enter;
15. Close File Explorer.
